SIZES

Cardigan is sized to fit
Women's Small (Medium,
Large, X, 2X, 3X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 32 (36, 40, 44, 48, 52)"

Length: 23 (23½, 24½, 25, 26,
26½)"

Upper Arm: 11½ (12½, 14, 15,
16½, 17½)"

MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn *Classic Shades*
*Sequins Lite*** (74% acrylic, 22%
wool, 4% payette; 100g/264
yds)

- 402 Storm Cloud with
silver sequins – 4 (4, 5,
5, 6, 6) balls

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) 32"
circular needles and set of dpn
or size to obtain gauge

Notions: Yarn needle, stitch
holders

GAUGE

18 sts x 26 rows = 4" in St st
Collar panel measures 4¼"
wide

Save time, check your gauge.

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STITCH GUIDE

Diamond Lace Panel

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, s2kp, yo, k5, yo, s2kp, yo, k3.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: * K1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk; rep from * to last st, k1

Row 5: K2tog, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, ssk.

Row 7: K2, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

Row 9: K3, [yo, ssk, k1] twice, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k3.

Row 11: [K1, yo, ssk] twice, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, [k1, k2tog, yo] twice, k1.

Row 13: K2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

Row 15: K3, yo, s2kp, yo, k5, yo, s2kp, yo, k3.

Row 17: K1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1.

Row 19: K2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, s2kp, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk.

Row 21: K2, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, k2.

Row 23: [K1, k2tog, yo] twice, k5, [yo, ssk, k1] twice.

Row 25: [K2tog, yo, k1] three times, [yo, ssk, k1] twice, yo, ssk.

Row 27: K2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

PATTERN NOTES

The body of this cardigan is knit in one piece, including lace collar, to underarms; the back and fronts are worked separately. Sleeves are knit in the round to underarms, and sleeve caps are shaped by working back and forth in rows.

CARDIGAN

Body

Using circ needle, cast on 172 (190, 206, 224, 240, 262) sts; do not join.

Set-up row (WS): K22, pm, k28 (32, 36, 40, 44, 50), pm for side, k72 (82, 90, 100, 108, 118), pm for side, k28 (32, 36, 40, 44, 50), pm, k22.

Work in garter st until piece meas 1" from cast on.

Establish Collar Pattern

Row 1 (RS): P3, work row 1 of diamond lace panel over 17 sts, p2, sl m, * knit to m, sl m; rep from * 2 more times, p2, work row 1 of diamond lace panel over 17 sts, p3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, work next row of patt over 17 sts, k2, * purl to m, sl m; rep from * 3 more times, k2, work next row of patt over 17 sts, k3.

Cont in patt, keeping 3 sts each collar edge and 2 sts bet collar and sweater body in rev St st until piece meas 13 (13, 13½, 13½, 14, 14)" from cast on, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck

Neck shaping will occur at the same time as armhole shaping

Next row (neck dec): Work across collar sts, sl m, ssk, * knit to m, sl m; rep from * 1 more time, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m, work to end – 2 sts dec'd. Rep neck dec row every 8 (8, 10, 10, 8, 8) rows, 7 (7, 7, 7, 8, 9) more times.

At the same time, when piece meas 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17, 17)" from cast on, ending with a WS row, beg armhole shaping.

Separate front and back/shape armholes

Next row (RS): Work to 4 (5, 6, 8, 9, 10) sts bef side m, place sts just worked (right front sts) on holder, bind off 8 (10, 12, 16, 18, 20) sts for underarm, work to 4 (5, 6, 8, 9, 10) sts bef next side m, place sts just worked on holder (back sts) bind off 8 (10, 12, 16, 18, 20) sts, work to end.

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Left front: Work a WS row. **Next row**

(armhole dec): K1, k2tog, work to end – 1 st dec'd. Rep dec row every RS row 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 8) more times, *while cont to shape neck*. After all armhole and neck shaping is complete, you should have 35 (37, 39, 40, 41, 43) sts total – 22 sts for collar, and 13 (15, 17, 18, 19, 21) sts for shoulder. Work even until front meas 7 (7½, 8, 8 1/2, 9, 9½)" from armhole bind off, ending with a WS row. Place 22 collar sts on holder, (being sure to note which row of the diamonds pattern you ended on) and place shoulder sts on separate holder.

Right front

Place held sts on needle and work a WS row. **Next row (dec):** Work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep dec row every RS row 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 8) more times, *while cont to shape neck*. After all armhole and neck shaping is complete, you should have 35 (37, 39, 40, 41, 43) sts total – 22 sts for collar, and 13 (15, 17, 18, 19, 21) sts for shoulder. Work even until front meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½)" from armhole bind off, ending with a WS row. Place 22 collar sts on holder, (being sure to note which row of the diamonds pattern you ended on) and place shoulder sts on separate holder.

Back

Place held sts on needle and work a WS row. **Next row (dec) (RS):** K1, k2tog, work to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep dec row every RS row 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 8) more times – 58 (64, 68, 72, 76, 80) sts. Work even until back meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½)" from armhole bind off, ending with a WS row. Work across 13 (15, 17, 18, 19, 21) sts, place these sts on holder for shoulder, bind off center 32 (34, 34, 36, 38, 38), work to end, place rem sts on holder for shoulder.

Sleeves

Using dpn, cast on 53 (55, 57, 59, 63, 65) sts; pm and join to work in the rnd. Purl 1 rnd. Knit 1 rnd. Rep these 2 rnds (garter st) until cuff meas 1". **Next rnd:** K21 (22, 23, 24, 26, 27) sts, pm, work rnd 1 of sleeve chart over 11 sts, pm, knit to end. Cont in patt, maintaining sts on either side of marker in St st, until rnds 1-24 have been worked. Purl 1 rnd, removing markers. **Next rnd (dec):** Knit, dec 10 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12) sts evenly across rnd—43 (45, 47, 49, 51, 53) sts. Purl 1 rnd. Knit 1 rnd.

Shape sleeve

Next rnd (inc): K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep an inc rnd every 12 (8, 6, 4, 4, 4) rnds, 3 (5, 7, 8, 10, 12) more times – 11 (57, 63, 67, 73, 79) sts. Work even in St st until sleeve meas 12½ (12½, 13, 13, 13½, 13½)".

Shape cap

Next row: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 9) sts, knit to end; remove marker. **Next row (WS):** Bind off 3 (4, 5, 6, 7, 9) sts, purl to end – 43 (47, 51, 51, 55, 59) sts. **Next row (RS):** K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. rep dec row every RS row 15 (17, 19, 19, 20, 22) more times, and then every other RS row 0 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1) more time. Bind off rem 11 sts.

FINISHING


Collar: Left collar: Place held sts back on needle and work in patt for 3½ (3¾, 3¾, 4, 4¼, 4½)" more. Knit 2 rows. Bind off all sts. Rep for right collar. Join shoulders with 3 needle bind off. Sew sleeves into armholes. Sew ends of collar tog. Sew free edges of collar to back neck. Weave in ends and block.

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Diamond Lace Pattern (worked over 17 sts) *




- k on RS, p on WS
- k2tog
- ssk
- yo
- s2kp
- patt rep

*all even numbered (WS) rows are purled
