## MANOS DELURUGUAY

## Fino Shadow Cowl

SIZE
$24 \frac{1}{2}$ " circumference $\times 121 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ deep

## MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FINO (70\% extrafine merino, 30\% silk), I mini-skein kit (5 skeins, each approx. 20g/98yds). Shown in FM08 Henrietta (42I Havisham [A], 40I Corsage [B], 408 Crystal Goblet [C], 404 Watered Silk [D], 4I4 Ivory Letteropener [E]).

US \#5/3.75mm 16" circular ndl, or size to obtain gauge Ring marker
Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

24 sts and 40 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Shadow Pattern

## STITCH GUIDE

Shadow Pattern (any number of stitches)
Rnd I:With MC, knit to end of rnd. Remove m, $k$ into st below first st on left ndl, replace $m$ on right ndl.
Rnd 2: With MC, knit.
Rnd 3 : With CC, knit to end of rnd. Remove m, $k$ into st below first st on left ndl, replace $m$ on right ndl.
Rnd 4: With CC, purl.
Rep Rnds I through 4 for Shadow Pattern.
rep: repeat
rnd: round
st(s): stitch(es)

## INSTRUCTIONS

With E, cast on 150 sts. Join, being careful not to twist, and place marker to show beginning of rnd. (Purl I rnd, knit I rnd) twice. Join B and, beginning with Rnd 3, work 20 rnds of Shadow Pattern using E as MC and B as CC. Cut E.

Join A and continue in Shadow Pattern for 24 rnds, using A as $M C$ and $B$ as $C C$. Cut $B$.

Join $D$ and continue in Shadow Pattern for 20 rnds, using $A$ as $M C$ and $D$ as CC. Cut $A$.

Join C and continue in Shadow Pattern for 28 rnds, using $C$ as $M C$ and $D$ as CC. Cut D.

Rejoin E and continue in Shadow Pattern for 20 rnds, using C as MC and E as CC. Cut C.

Rejoin $B$ and continue in Shadow Pattern for 14 rnds, using B as $M C$ and $E$ as CC. Cut $E$.

Continuing with B alone, (knit I rnd, purl I rnd) twice. Bind off knitwise. Cut yarn and fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Steam-block if desired.
